Pearson, an English teacher from Corbridge Middle School, came to deliver an English lesson to the Year 4 children. We also invited our new Reception grown-ups into school for their welcome meeting.

Years 3 and 4 had an exciting day on Wednesday as they travelled to Beamish to further their history learning. We travelled back in time to 1913 to see what life was like just after the Victorian era with a focus on mining. We spent the day in the Pit Village exploring the colliery buildings, the village houses and gardens. There were quite a few nervous faces entering the school building for our Victorian lesson but everyone was brilliant and got to grips with the quill and ink very quickly. The children were also lucky enough to go down the mine and were astonished by how dark, cold and damp it was. I would like to say another huge thank you to Consett Rotary for funding the tickets, and also treating the children to an ice cream. What a treat!

Children from Reception to Year 4 had their first taste of golf this year on Tuesday with professional coach Craig Smith, from Close House. The children LOVED learning how to drive and we saw some incredible shots. The coaching will continue weekly over this half term and then they will be lucky enough to visit Close House and receive further coaching.

Our week ended with our annual Teddy Bears' Picnic, which was a delight.

Finally, I would like to share that I am a very proud headteacher indeed. Our Year 1, Year 2 and Year 4 children have all completed statutory tests over the last few weeks (Phonics Screening Check and Multiplication Tables Check), and have been brilliant! Whilst they may not have always been aware they were doing assessments, they all worked so hard and were the absolute best they could be. We have all been so impressed by their resilience and positive attitudes.
