



Dyslexia Friendly Classroom strategies

All staff are teachers of learners with dyslexic traits!

At Broomhaugh and Corbridge First Schools we support learners with dyslexic traits to access the curriculum on a personalised approach that can include:

- Use of visual aids.
- Use of simple verbal and written instructions.
- Use of dyslexia-friendly fonts e.g. Ariel
- Avoiding asking children to read in front of the whole class unless we know they are confident to do so and with the text.
- Providing a clear line of sight for non-verbal communication.
- Providing memory cues such as alphabet strips, speed sounds charts and numbers.
- Having regular learning breaks.
- Writing clearly on the white board.
- Use of coloured overlays and reading rulers.
- Use of pastel paper for printed resources.
- Repitition of reading/vocabulary learning.
- Marking focussing on content rather then spelling/grammar.
- Consideration of alternative forms of recording
