English Focus text: Winter Sleep Key Skills

Artist – Claude Monet Genre – Painting and Collage

<u>Key Skills</u>

Use of watercolours to create a colour wash (flat, variegated and graded)

Experiment with different tints, shades and tones. Collage based on drawings using tissue paper Developing layering, cutting and tearing to create different effects.

Each child will produce:

 A watercolour background inspired by 'The Water Lily Pond' (Monet), using a bridge template to mask a bridge silhouette whilst painting. Line drawings of water lilies

A large tissue paper water lily (collage) and smaller water lilies to add 3D effect to original painting.
