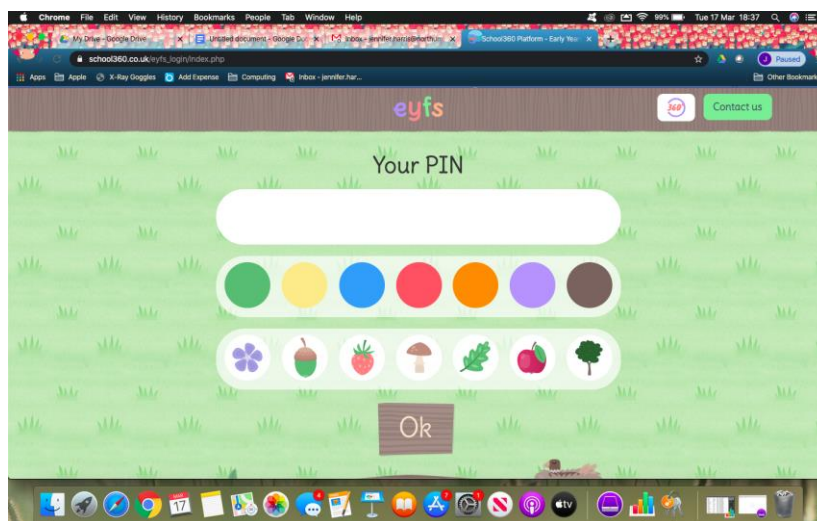


School360 Information For Parents

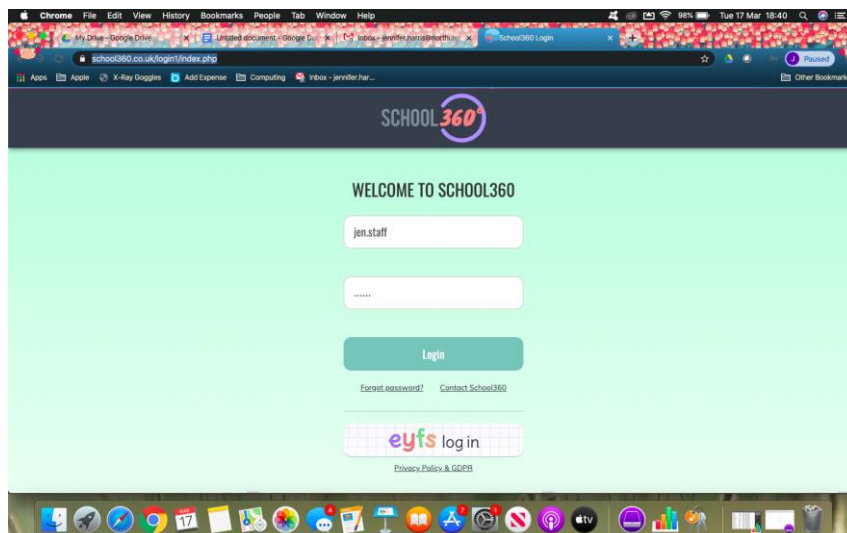
School360 is an online connected classroom which can be accessed on an internet enabled device. (PC, laptop, Macbook, tablet). Teachers and pupils have their own unique login details to access the site.

School360 includes a range of resources to support teaching and learning both in the classroom and at home. Your child's teacher is able to set tasks and assignments to be completed using these resources.

Younger children will log in here: https://school360.co.uk/eyfs_login with a 5 digit pin number, colour and picture provided by their teacher.

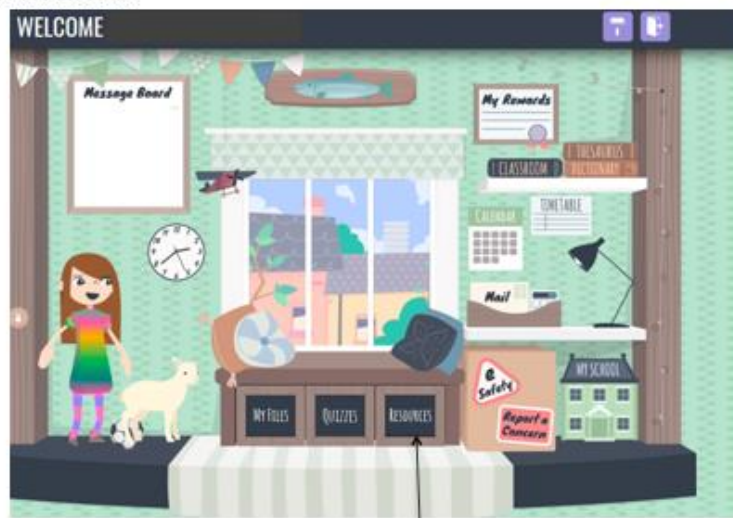
