STEM WEEK 2 – Reception Class

STEM WEEK 2 – Class Two (Y3/4)

The witches and wizards of Hogwarts finished creating the outer structures of their Mandrake Silencers. They used their knowledge of sound proofing to add at least two layers of insulating materials to their models in the hope of silencing the deafening scream of the strange plant. In addition to this, STEM partners measured, cut, decorated and added panels to their structure in order to disguise the silencer so as not to alarm the mandrakes in the greenhouse!

Professor Brainstorm performed his 'Magical Science Show' for us and it was truly fantastic - from using bananas as hammers to disappearing water...he proved that 'SCIENCE IS FUN'!

A huge thank you to Technology Tom for his workshop. He set us the task of designing and making a Mandrake Trap structure with a working mechanism - this was a lot of fun and certainly challenged our problem-solving skills!
