Lesson	Activity/ Link
1	Compile a list of what you would change to make your community a better place.
	For example, having more rubbish bins, cars driving slower, creating more parks.
	Choose one of your ideas and think about how you could make this idea happen by
	creating a mind map.
2	 Using your mind map write a script about your idea to make the community a
	better place and discuss how you think this could be achieved.
3	 Using Microsoft Word/ Publisher/ PowerPoint or another similar program, create a
	poster to advertise your proposal.
	 Import pictures, photographs, experiment with font styles, sizes, colours etc.
4	 Create a film or an animation to promote your proposal (a bit like an advert).
	 With the support of an adult, record yourself reading your script using a camera,
	tablet or phone with video capabilities.
	 You could use props/ figures/ objects to create an animation and narrate your
	script over the top or just read the script yourself.
5	Watch back your recording and think about how you could make it better next
	time.
	If you like you can always re record your film or animation with your
	improvements.
