## **Year 3 Autumn Term Times Tables**

Please find below a list of the times tables that have been set for Year 3 homework for the rest of this term. The dates given are when the children will have a quick **6 minute quiz** to see how they are getting on. To start with, we will begin by revisiting tables with which the children are already familiar. This is so that they can get used to the format and routine. The children tried this out with the 10x table last Friday and did really well.

Times tables can be practised in many different ways including: online games/apps, chanting/singing, paper and pencil, grouping objects, applying them to practical everyday situations etc. The challenge for those children who are already confident is speed. Whilst the children have opportunities in school to practise and apply these facts, we rely on your continued support at home. Being secure in recalling multiplication facts is vital for children to develop their mathematical fluency skills. It frees up their working memory and helps them to grasp more readily other concepts. Our aim is to make this fun and stress-free.

Once logged in, the following areas are the most useful.

Jamming	<ul> <li>No time limit.</li> <li>Simply choose the times table you need to practise from the list above.</li> <li>You decide whether you would like to practise multiplication only or with division.</li> <li>You can even choose how many questions you would like to try.</li> </ul>
Garage	<ul> <li>Short games set up weekly by us for the children to practise the tables from the above homework list.</li> <li>Both multiplication and division facts tested</li> </ul>

For any Year 3 Rock Stars who would like to try something more adventurous!

Studio	1 minute games covering tables up to 12 x 12 (both multiplication and division)
	Children try to get at least one right answer in every Studio game.
	They will be given their first 'Rock Status' when they have scored in 10 Studio games
Sound	25 questions up to 12 x 12 (both multiplication and division)
Check	6 seconds per question
	Mimics the Multiplication Tables Check that will take place at the end of Year 4.
