This week our literacy challenges are based on the story, 'Ten little rubber ducks'.

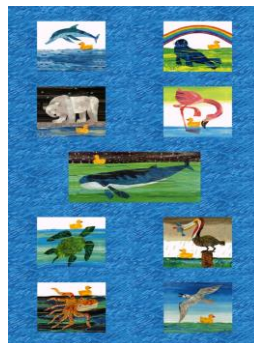
You can begin by listening to the story. We've suggested these follow up activities to consolidate a range of reading and writing skills previously taught in school.
