### <u>Literacy challenges</u> Week beginning 1.6.20


This week our literacy challenges are based on the story, 'Ten little rubber ducks'.




# Monday - draw the pictures of the animals that the rubber ducks went past

### Thursday - Write a postcard to a friend?


Imagine that you were one of the ducks and had been on an adventure?
