PARENTS INTO SCHOOL WEEK-Unfortunately we do not have a completely free week to hold this activity before Easter so we will do this the week beginning Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May. A timetable will be put up the week beginning Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April for any parents who can come into lessons to help - sessions will be for an hour and two parents can attend each session.
