Welcome to the tricky world of the Greek Alphabet! Can you investigate Greek letters and words and have a go at writing some common words and even your name!

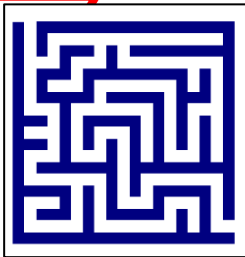
