It has been another exciting and busy week in school. For such a short term, we really are managing to fit in a lot!



On Tuesday, Class One and the choir travelled to the Civic Centre in Newcastle to take part in the Royal Opera House performance of 'The Magic Flute' by Mozart. They were amazed by the talented singers and all of the instruments in the orchestra. It was such an amazing opportunity to sing with professionals and I was so proud of all of the children.

Excitingly, a team of Year 8 students from Corbridge Middle School called the 'Go Green Gorillas' have been in touch with us. They are doing all they can to encourage other schools to start gardening and promote biodiversity. The team of 12 and 13-year-olds won the Young Green Briton Challenge in June 2023 with their enthusiasm and ideas to get more children outside growing their own food. The Go Green Gorillas wanted to assist schools in the North East that might not be eligible for central funding but could still do with materials to improve nature and set them on a journey to grow their own food. They are sending out a book, seed packets, instructions and a voucher for compost and pots to 16 local schools, including Broomhaugh First School! This will be delivered to school next week and received by our Eco Council. We can't wait to get sowing and growing!

Our KS2 football tournament also took place on Tuesday and we travelled to join our friends at Corbridge First School. Not only was it wonderful to see all of the children's fantastic skills put into practice, it was one of many occasions for our Year 4 children to come together and start building bonds of friendship ahead of the upcoming residential and transition to middle school.

Finally, our School and Eco Council members attended Tanga Club in Hexham, our chosen local charity. This was a chance for the councillors to see their fundraising in action, as part of our work on courageous advocacy, and also experience the wonderful club. What a lovely way to end the week!
