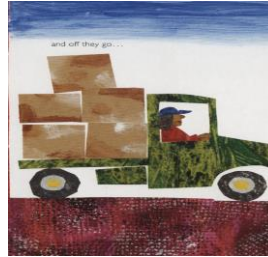


Week beginning 1.6.20

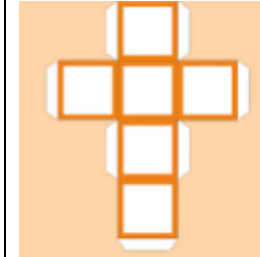
Make truck to carry the boxes to the cargo ship.

Will your truck move?

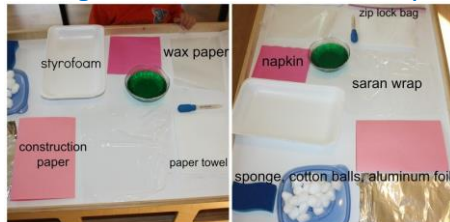
Make your own box using a cube net

You could try:

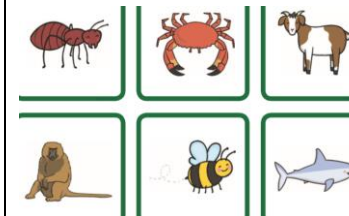
- Cotton wool
