Comments and Actions

- Due to the nature of the topic to be discussed, just the KS2 GGs attended the meeting.
- Update: This morning, Gwyn from Scouts was in school to meet the children and grown-ups. She discussed that the Beavers and Cubs were going to paint rocks to create a Ukrainian flag as a way of showing support for the many people who are suffering due to the war. School will then receive half of these painted rocks. GGs agreed it would be lovely to put these in the Secret Garden to create an area where students can go to reflect.
- Mrs Symes, one of our governors, asked Mrs Hart about the front of school this
 morning and whether any planting was going ahead. Mrs Hart asked the GGs what
 could be planted and it was decided that we would get a variety of blue and yellow
 flowers (pansies or primroses) and plant them around the wooden squirrel sculpture.
 These would represent our school colours but would also show support for the
 people of Ukraine as they are the colours of the flag, too.
- GGs to write a letter asking for donations from a local garden centre.
- Squirrels after-school club are also working hard on their outdoor area. Special thanks go to Mr Gardner for making a planter and Mrs Walsh for buying strawberry plants to go in it!
- Mrs Hart to ask for compost donations on the newsletter.
