Challenge: can you learn the names of all of continents and ocean in the world?	Research how you say hello, thank you and goodbye in Chinese. Show the class what you have learnt. Challenge: Can you learn anymore Chinese words?

Year 1 Mental Maths Focus this half term:

- To count, read and write numbers to 100.
- Number bonds to 20.
- Counting forward and back in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- To read the time to the nearest hour and half hour.
- Recall and write the days of the week and the months of the year.

Year 2 Mental Maths Focus this half term:

- Number of minutes in a second and an hour and number of hours in a day.
- Telling the time to the nearest quarter hour (when secure to the nearest 5 minutes)
- Rapid recall of number bond to 20 and 100 e.g. ____ + 45 = 100?
- Recall multiplication and division facts for the 10, 5, 3 and 2 times table.
