<u>Key Skills</u>


<u>Key Skills</u>

- Use of watercolours to create a colour wash (flat, variegated and graded)
- Experiment with different tints, shades and tones.
- Collage based on drawings using tissue paper
- Developing layering, cutting and tearing to create different effects.
 - Each child will produce:
- A watercolour background inspired by 'The Water Lily Pond' (Monet), using a bridge template to mask a bridge silhouette whilst painting.
- Line drawings of water lilies
- A large tissue paper water lily (collage) and smaller water lilies to add 3D effect to original painting.
