Comments and Actions

- Mr Gardner met with the Global Goalkeepers to discuss the problem of leaves in the school ground. They are everywhere and there are so many! He has bought a new leaf blower to help contain them and clear them away but needs help with a new project. The plan, thanks to Bethan's idea, is to collect the leaves and put them into a purpose-built composter! We can then use the compost in the Secret Garden.
 - ACTION: GGs to return to class and create a rota of leaf collectors. These
 children will be able to leave class five minutes early for break and, using
 special gloves and tools, collect the piles of leaves and transport them to the
 compost area.
 - o 2 children per class needed daily.
- Mrs Hart showed the GGs the four new litter pickers that have been bought for school. Following the high winds and storms, there is a lot of rubbish floating around the school grounds. The Goalkeepers will use the pickers and gardening gloves to clear this during lunchtimes.
- AOB: Bethan asked if we could do a sustainability survey of the resources used in school. Mrs Hart agreed to put it on a future agenda.
