Alternative Spelling For 'oi' / 'oy'

As part of their phonics session this week it would be great if you can access some of the super phonics games through school 360. Here are the steps to access them and the ones we would recommend.

Here you will find a variety of fun games looking at some of the alternative spellings we have covered so far including this weeks which is 'oi' . I recommend **Baseball Bash**, **Cat Splat and Fridge Bites**

Here is a resource where the children can type in the type of oi/oy to make the correct word in the sentence.

Using the worksheet oi/oy table. Set a timer, how many different oi/oy words can you think of and spell correctly? Alternatively go on a walk and take a clipboard and record any oi/oy words you can find e.g. toy, boy, soil, foil etc

Work through 'oi' presentation under resources on Y1 Learning menu. Once you have read and worked through the London story get a small toy figure and get the toy to travel around the London map reading some of the street names and talking about what they might see. Would they find anything with an oi/oy sound? How would you spell it? Make up oi/oy street names for the map made up. Try writing the sentence It gave me joy to buy a toy with my coins in London.

Write some oi/oy words on strips of paper, hide them in the house or In the garden. When your child finds them they must say the word out loud. Once found they pick some to go into sentences and write them down.

Examples of oi/oy words

- Toy, boy, coy, joyful, enjoy, ploy, soy
- Boil, voice, coin, soil, foil, spoil, noise, choice, moist, point








Adverts on a Billboard
